The OCO must work to departmental procedures and industry regulations. You should be both proactive and reactive, have excellent problem-solving skills with a high attention to detail and have the ability to thrive in a fast-paced environment.

- Ensuring the use of crew is safe and cost-effective.

- Acting as the principal point of contact for crew roster queries.
- Daily administration of crew HOTAC and transport.
- Liaising with partner airlines, group companies and contracted third-party providers.
- Production of FTL reports to ensure compliance and avoidance of fatigue in aircrew.

- Production of key statistical information on request from the CCM.
- Supporting the Operations Control Officer when needed.
