The role will be responsible for providing Material Management insupport of all aircraft material and services. - Deliver and manage a warehouse and storage solution in support of worldwide operations.
- Manage contracted logistics providers for UK, EU and ROW material shipments.
- Define departmental processes.
- Manage key suppliers and act as point of escalation
- Review contracted supplier SLAs and KPIs, providing feedback to the Senior Management Team
- Develop communication strategies whilst managing relationships with key internal departments
- An awareness of lean processes to identify and implement or improve costs and time saving initiatives.
- Deputise for the Head of Procurement as and when required.
