- Directly responsible for meeting critical deadlines and exacting customer requirements to ensure business growth as well as retaining existing customers through contract renewals.
- Requires considerable concentration and attention to detail when dealing with and responding to complex bid requirements.
- A consistently high quality of work is required to ensure the best chance of securing new business.
- The role may require some travel and out-of-hours work.
