- Coordinate system version upgrades, testing, and release management.
- Monitor business-scheduled tasks (including interfaces) and resolve scheduled job issues.
- Document, control, and manage post go-live customizations across all airlines to ensure a degree of uniformity and traceability.
- Travel internationally for subsidiary company implementations, training, and support.
