Any additional services in line with customer or airline requirements.
- Act as the point of contact between customers, suppliers and airline partners for all charter operations.
- Publish the final charter handover to the Operations Control team and Commercial departments, as well as external customers, -72hrs to STD or when trip setup has been finalised.
- Ensure all requested services and supplier information are recorded in company IT software.
- Approve invoices for services arranged by the department.
