## You will be responsible for:

- Working under the supervision of the Engineering Manager as part of the engineering team to ensure all maintenance and certification of SmartLynx Australia aircraft comply with regulatory, manufacturer, and Part 145 MOE requirements.
- Carrying out scheduled and unscheduled maintenance, including primary line maintenance activities, to maintain the ongoing serviceability and presentation of company aircraft on a daily basis.
- Researching and ensuring the availability of parts for upcoming maintenance, testing equipment and tooling, and undertaking corrective rectification of aircraft systems and defects, including those away from base.
- Contributing to the safety and quality management systems and travelling to other bases when required.
- Candidates must clearly demonstrate in their application:
- For the B1 LAME position: a valid CASA license
- For the AME position: a Certificate IV or Diploma in Aeroskills (preferably in Mechanical or Avionics)
- Experience on Dash 8 100 / 200 and 300 desirable.
- Thorough knowledge and understanding of maintenance procedures
- Ability to work effectively as part of a professionally diverse team, but also have the ability to work unsupervised

- Strong work ethic with the ability to work well under pressure
- Ability to successfully obtain an ASIC (Aviation Security Identification Card) and provide applicable police clearances, including from country of citizenship
